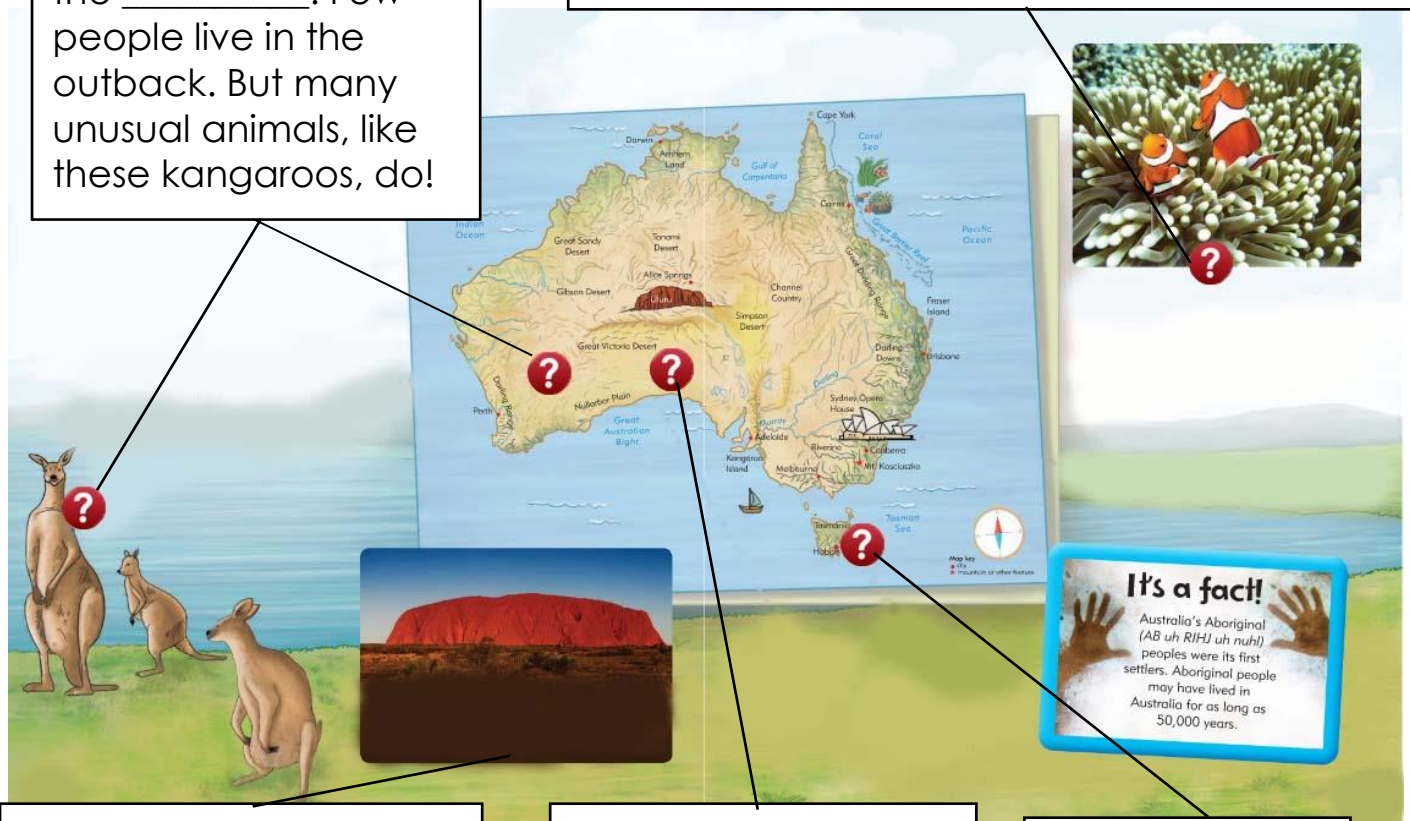
# Australia
