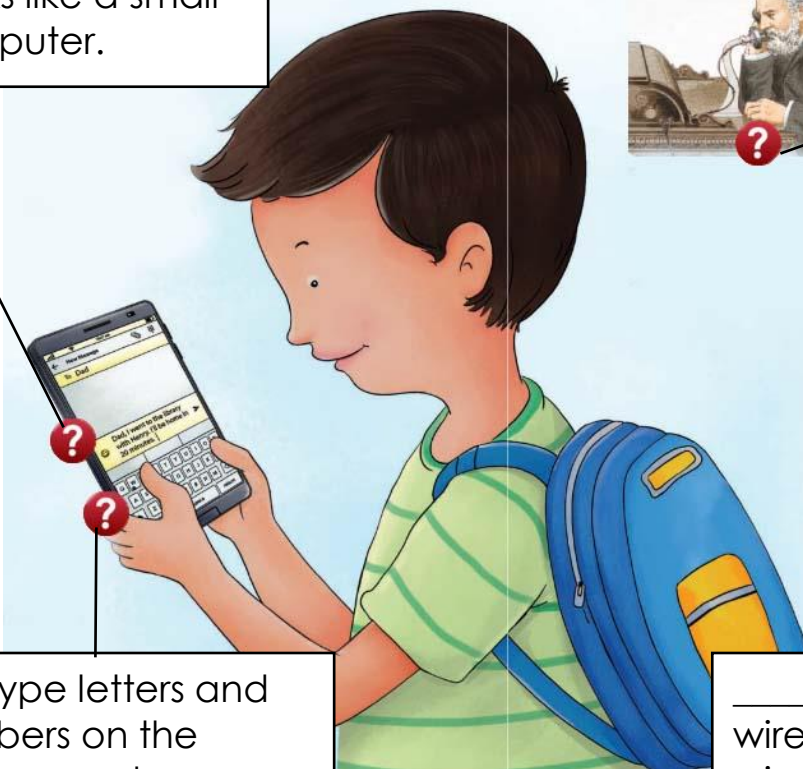
# Telephone
