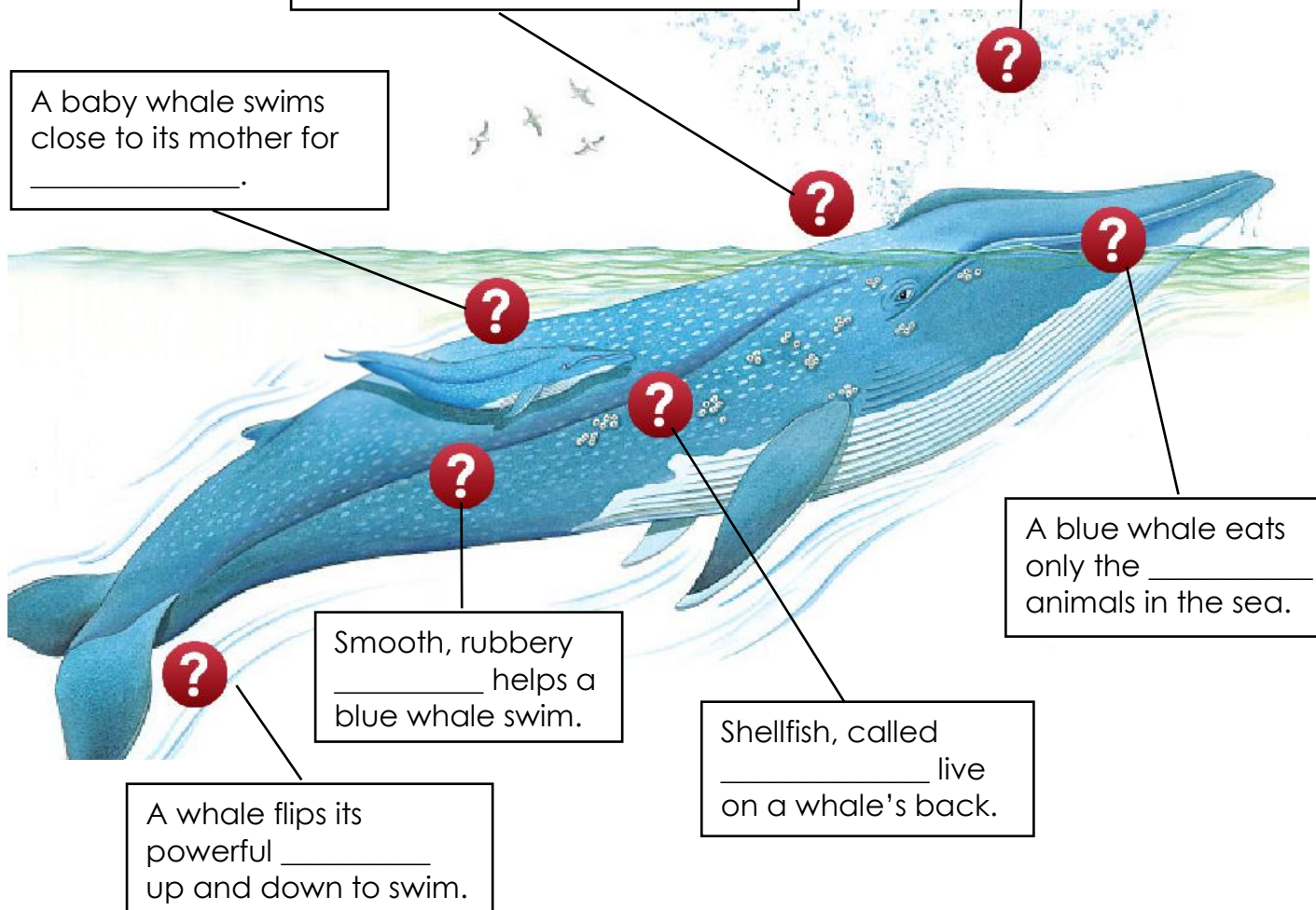
# Dolphin and whale
