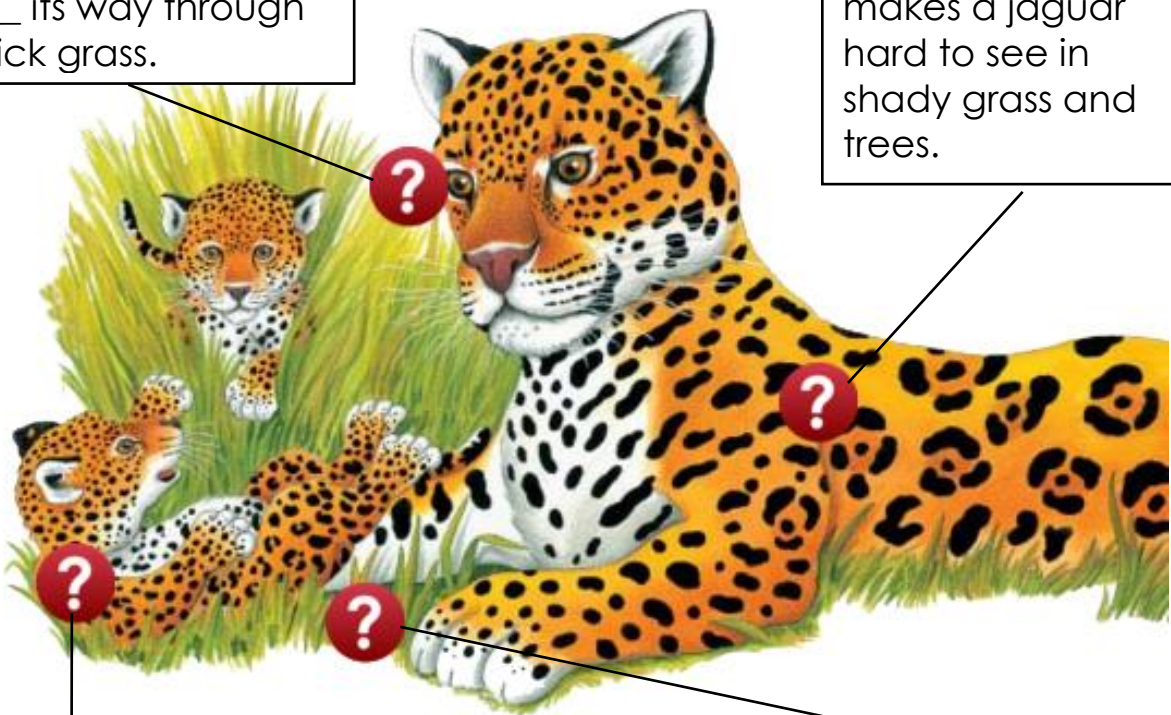


Jaguar
